Seminar Series

Care and Democracy is a seminar series organized by The Center for Critical Democracy Studies dedicated to the dialogue between Care Ethics and Democratic Theory. This series will explore how the relational aspects of care—often focused on dependency and moral responsibility—can offer profound insights into democratic practices.

By considering care as both a normative and political framework, the seminars will critically engage with how care ethics challenges conventional liberal-democratic ideals. In doing so, they will offer fresh perspectives on key concepts such as citizenship, power, and social cohesion.

The inaugural session was held on October 10 at 17h30, with a conversation between seminar organizers Sandra Laugier (Université Paris 1, Panthéon-Sorbonne) and Zona Zarić (Center for Critical Democracy Studies, The American University of Paris).

Future sessions will include contributions from leading scholars such as Fabienne Brugère (Université Paris 8), Barbara Formis (Université Paris 1, Panthéon-Sorbonne), Patricia Paperman (Université Paris 8), Carol Gilligan (New York University) and Valentina Moro (Stony Brook).
